# Motocross

## 2010 QUAD STATE CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

### THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The Senior Motocross Sporting Panel will select six (6) events for Quad Championship and four (4) for Juniors during the 2010 calendar year as State Motocross Championship Rounds.

Womens Quads and Veteran Quad Championship classes will compete in one(1) round.

The Championship will be promoted by WAMX {the Promoter}, WJMC, Manjimup MC, Southern Capes MCC.

### The Senior Championship classes

Quad Championship	-2 Stroke up to 550cc + 4 Stroke to 700cc
Womens Quad	-2 Stroke up to 550cc + 4 Stroke to 700cc
Veterans Quad 35+ years	-2 Stroke up to 550cc + 4 Stroke to 700cc

### Quad Championship

There will be three heats for the championship class conducted at each of the 6 "MX Championship Rounds" and each championship will be decided under the Motorcycling Australia point scoring system as stated in the 2010 MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport. Points will be awarded in each championship heat and all points will count.

If any Quad State Championship heats are cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the championship can be declared on the completion of Thirteen (13) of the eighteen (18) heats. Riders may not drop any heats in order to score better results.

The competition will be conducted under Motorcycling Australia permit as issued by MWA and run under the rules as stated in the 2010 MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these State Championship Regulations and the event Supplementary Regulations.

### SEEDED RIDERS

For the first state round in 2010 the top 5 placed riders for 2009 in the Pro Quads class, will be automatically seeded into that class.

After each round the top five placegetters in each class will automatically be seeded into the next round.

### RACE CONDITIONS

3 Heats 10 mins + 1lap (for Rounds 1,3,4,5 and 6)

Rnd 2 – 2 Heats 15mins + 1 Lap + 1 x 6 Lap Sprint

### Womens Quads & Veteran Quads

There will be three(3) heats for these Championship class conducted at one(1) round of the MX Championships and each Championship will be decided under the Motorcycling Australia point scoring system as stated in the 2010 MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport. Points will be awarded in each championship heat and all points will count.

The competition will be conducted under Motorcycling Australia permit as issued by MWA and run under the rules as stated in the 2010 MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these State Championship Regulations and the event Supplementary Regulations.

## RACE CONDITIONS

3 Heats x 4 laps

### Senior Support Classes

Clubman Quads Group A -2 Stroke up to 550cc + 4 Stroke to 700cc

Clubman Quads Group B -2 Stroke up to 550cc + 4 Stroke to 700cc

### Junior Quads

The three Junior Quad Championship classes competing for State Championships will be

Junior 90cc 2 Stroke - 110cc 4 Stroke Standard 7years to Under 13years

Junior 90cc 2 Stroke - 110cc 4 Stroke Modified 9 years to Under 13years

Junior 200cc 2 Stroke - 300cc 4 Stroke 12yrs to U/16yrs

There will be three heats for the championship class's conducted at each of the four (4) State Rounds" and each championship will be decided under the Motorcycling Australia point scoring system as stated in the 2010 MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport. Points will be awarded in each championship heat and all points will count.

If any Junior State Championship heats are cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the championship can be declared on the completion of Nine (9) of the Twelve (12) heats. Riders may not drop any heats in order to score better results.

The competition will be conducted under Motorcycling Australia permit as issued by MWA and run under the rules as stated in the 2010 MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these State Championship Regulations and the event Supplementary Regulations.

### ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS

Entries for Championship classes will only be received from holders of a current "National" Motorcycling Australia competition licence. Holders of a "National" licence are eligible for State Championship points.

### MINIMUM/MAXIMUM NUMBERS

A Maximum of twenty (20) riders will be accepted for each class. The minimum number of entries required to constitute a class will be 25% of the total grid for each championship class. There shall be a minimum number of 25% of the total grid starters required at the commencement of each State Championship heat for championship points to be allocated.

### AWARDS AND PRIZE MONEY

Quad Championship 1<sup>st</sup> \$450; 2<sup>nd</sup> \$400; 3<sup>rd</sup> \$360; 4<sup>th</sup> \$330; 5<sup>th</sup> \$300

Women Quad's 1<sup>st</sup> \$175, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$150, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$125

Quad Veterans 1<sup>st</sup> \$175, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$150, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$125

Quad Championships shall be paid to a minimum of 3<sup>rd</sup> maximum of 5<sup>th</sup>

The promoter will supply awards to the first three overall placegetters in the 3 Junior Quad State Championships at the completion of their Series. All Senior Championship Awards will be awarded at the end of year function which placegetters are required to attend.

### NUMBERS - JUNIORS

Seeded Numbers 1 to 5 in plates will be allocated to the 200cc 2 stoke- 300cc 4 stroke 12 to under16, these numbers can be used in the 2011 Season.
