INFORMATION PERTAINS TO: MX1 and MX2 plate colours at Western Australian events

REASONING:

Motorcycling Australia made changes to the required plate colours for MX1/SX1 and MX2/SX2 in the 2026 MoMS. As the machine eligibility for both MX1 and MX2 differs between Australian Championship (ProMX) and State and Club level events Motorcycling Western Australia have decided to ease the current 2026 MoMS number plate colours required for MX1 and MX2 and supply some clarity.

For the 2026 Western Australian State Championship events and Open events, riders should display the plate colours that correspond with their primary category. If you enter MX2 on an eligible MX2 machine, you should display White Numbers on a Black background. If your machine would not be eligible for MX2 – 251cc or above, you should display MX1 plate which feature Black Numbers on a White background.

Riders eligible to enter both classes (dual classing) on the same machine will not be made to change plate colours for each class or penalised for displaying the incorrect plate colour.

This rule clarification will only apply to MWA sanctioned events within Western Australia. If competing in other states or nationally, the relevant RCB ruling will apply.
